## Overview

The 28th Annual Children's Water Education Festival, the largest event of its kind in the nation, welcomed more than 5,800 third through fifth grade students for a free, educational field trip focused on local water issues. Hosted by the Orange County Water District (OCWD), the Festival took place April 23–24 at Oak Canyon Park in Silverado. Surrounded by a scenic, mountain-lined backdrop, students participated in hands-on activities centered around water and STEM education.

**5,805** students attended the event, with participation from **70** schools and more than **230** classes representing **19** cities across Orange County.
