

School Rules and Regulations

Thank you for your interest in the Children's Water Education Festival. For the safety and enjoyment of all Festival guests, the following guidelines were developed. Please note that this list is not meant to be all inclusive and rules may change at any time. Additional information will be provided with your class confirmation packet. Thank you for your cooperation and please contact us if you have and questions or require additional information.



1. The Festival will take place rain or shine. Please plan accordingly.
2. All classes must pre-register for the Festival and be approved to attend.
3. Cancellations are extremely difficult to work around and we ask that you only register if you are certain your class can attend.
4. Classes must attend a minimum of four sessions, with priority given to classes that can attend the entire day. Being such a popular event, it is not fair to those waitlisted if your class can only stay for a few sessions.
5. Your schedule will be given at check in and no schedule changes will be made unless there is an error. You may not attend a presentation for which you are not scheduled.
6. Students, teachers and chaperones must bring a sack lunch. A 20-minute lunch break will be provided, and students will also have the option to bring a small snack for a break at the beginning of the festival. Water stations will be available throughout the Festival grounds. Please encourage your students to bring lunch items easily composted or recycled.
7. Recycling, compost and landfill containers will be set up throughout the Festival. Please dispose of waste in the appropriate container.
8. Transportation to and from the Festival is your responsibility. Please visit the bus funding tab at www.ChildrenWaterFestival.com for information on bus subsidies.
9. Attendees must wear closed-toe, closed-heel, flat shoes.
10. Behaviors that will not be tolerated (include, but are not limited to):
 - Running
 - Vandalism or defacing of Festival or Oak Canyon property
 - Theft
 - Foul language or clothing containing inappropriate language or themes
 - Yelling, screaming or other disruptive behavior
 - Inappropriate physical contact

You may be asked to leave the festival should any of the actions above be performed.
